Protect our natural areas!

- **Take action on Wolf Lake:** Help keep mining development out of this unique old growth forest here in Greater Sudbury.
 - Send an action fax at earthroots.org;
 - Call Minister Bartolucci: 705-675-1914 and ask that Wolf Lake be brought into the Chiniguchi Waterway Park AND that the existing mining claims and leases NOT be renewed.

Protect our lakes and waterways

Reduce the impact of development on the watershed!

- Make sure to **disconnect your downspout from your wastewater** (it will look like it is heading straight into the ground).
- **Reduce stormwater run-off** from your property: install a rain barrel, or a rain garden
- **Maintain a natural shoreline buffer** (at least 12m)
- **Maintain your septic systems**
- **Avoid contaminants reaching our lakes** (phosphorus, salt, etc) – don't put anything into a storm drain you wouldn't want to swim with



Join in! Join your local lake stewardship committee. Participate in events. Advocate for a wetland, Talk to others about how to take care of our precious lakes and waterways.



Safe, convenient, and connected cycling routes

- **Advocate for a safe and convenient network of cycling routes**
- **Get out on your bike**
- **Educate yourself and others** on safe cycling, and on sharing the road with cyclists when you are driving.



Join in! Join the Sudbury Cyclists Union. Take a bike safety course. Get cycling.

Speak up!
